1	Readiness panel	<p>Provides Larry with information about components of the system that aren't yet sufficiently set up to enable them to manage the availability of data:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Focuses solely on the things Larry needs to do to get the system properly configured. • Provides info about processes that have been successfully completed only if they're a trigger for something Larry needs to do to complete the configuration of the system. 	--
2	Top Five Events panel	<p>Lists the top five problem spots in the system affecting the availability of the data in the data sets.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Events are different from those in the Readiness panel in that they're things that have been working okay and have currently failed in some way. • Filters system events and presents only those that are most critical to Larry. 	--
3	Jobs panel	<p>Lists the tasks that Dolphin and the LKMs that it's managing have taken care of automatically -- or should have taken care of but weren't able to complete successfully.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scheduled backups are handled in their own panel, described in item 4. • Manual backups are listed in the Job panel because they don't qualify as "scheduled." 	--
4	Scheduled Backups panel	<p>Displays continually updated info about Dolphin's backup activities.</p> <p>Just updates the time of the event (and the name of the LKM it's backing up its keys to, if there's more than one) rather than listing each update as a separate event like the other panels. (Backing up keys to another LKM happens so frequently -- every five seconds -- listing each backup as a separate event would produce useless and excessive information.)</p>	--
5	Performance panel	<p>Displays warnings that indicate a performance problem or alert Larry to a potential performance problem.</p>	--
